


Reducing Fossil Fuel Use, Home Energy Costs & Carbon Emissions

The Upgrade & Save Rebate Program is administered by the Empire State Energy Association and the New York State Energy Coalition and sponsored by the National Oilheat Research Alliance. Together, these groups are working to transition New York homes to the next generation of low-carbon heating fuels and high-efficiency heating systems.
